Port of Tacoma Road Reconstruction Phase 2

May 2016 to July 2016

The City of Tacoma will reconstruct Port of Tacoma Road from Marshall Avenue to the State Route 509 bridge with concrete to meet heavy-haul standards.

With additional grant funding and contributions from the City and Port, the City's contractor, Gary Merlino Construction, will complete the final 1,600 feet of Port of Tacoma Road north of SR 509.

Construction is expected to begin May 9 and last 6 to 8 weeks.

Truck staging will remain the same during construction

Suggested truck routes:

Husky Terminal

- Portland: From Portland Ave., turn right on Lincoln and left on Thorne to the East 11th Street Staging Area
- Milwaukee: Use Milwaukee Way to access the East 11th Street Staging Area
- Avoid Port of Tacoma Road

Olympic Container Terminal

Continue to use Port of Tacoma Road

Washington United Terminals

- Portland Ave.: From Portland, turn right on Lincoln and left on Thorne to access the WUT Staging Area
- Port of Tacoma Rd.: From Port of Tacoma Rd., turn left on Lincoln and right on Thorne

Construction traffic impacts

The work will be reduce traffic to one lane in each direction throughout construction.

The work will be completed in three phases: (1) the two east lanes, (2) two west lanes and (3) the center lane.
