- **1 – 2 p.m.**

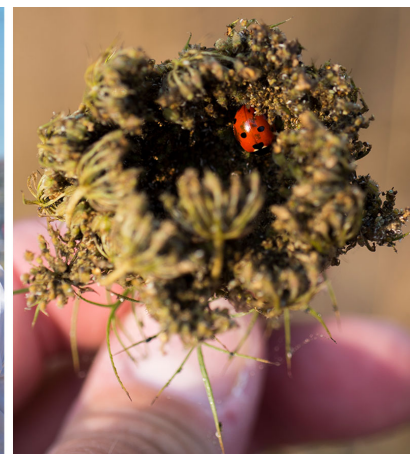

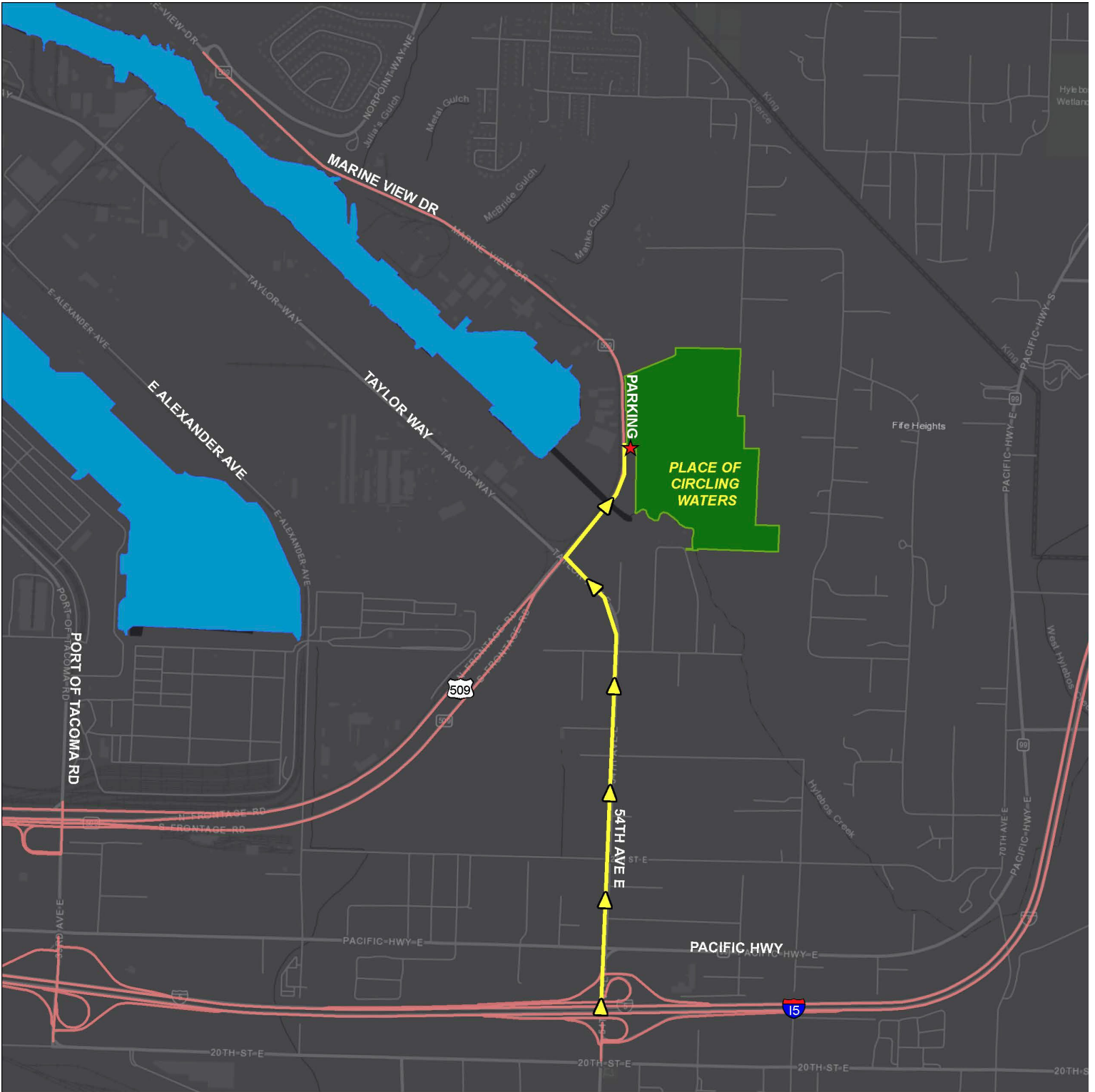
