In partnership with the Puyallup Tribe of Indians, the Port of Tacoma is restarting the Wapato Creek stream & wetland habitat project, located between 12th Street East and state Route 509. Over the next year, on-site and project work will include:

- Test pits & soil borings associated with geotechnical investigations.
- Additional survey & design work.
- Site maintenance, including mowing & removing invasive plants.
- Planning, environmental review, design & permitting.
